2014 Green Jobs Program

The Green Jobs program is a 6-week employment program for City-residents that provides participants with hands-on outdoor environmental work, career exploration, exposure to environmental issues, and a mentoring component. Participants who are 14-18 years old will work 25 hours per week and earn minimum wage.
