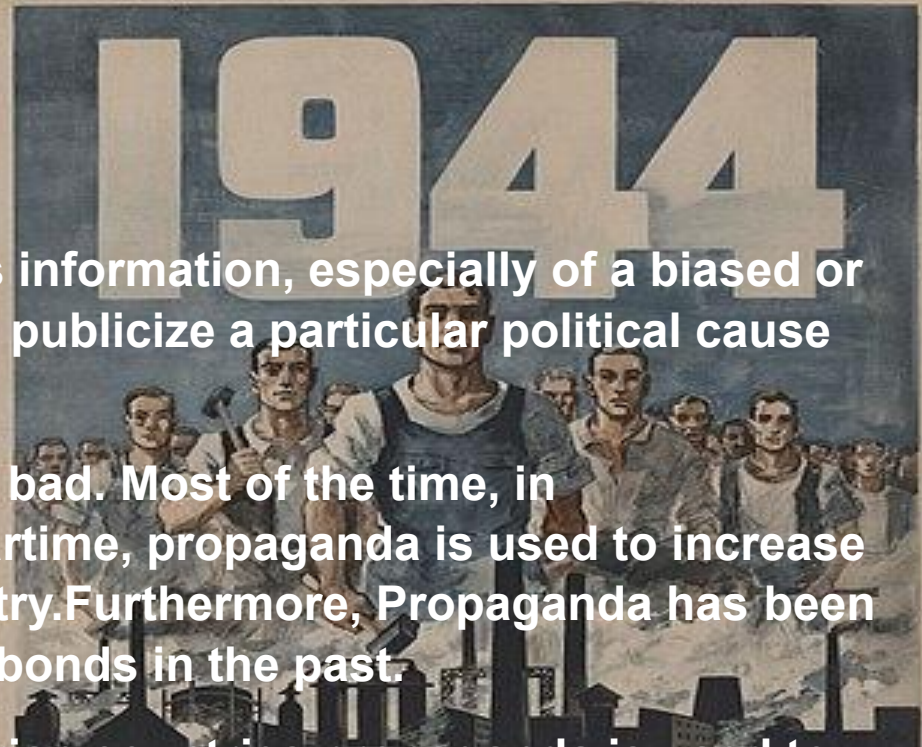
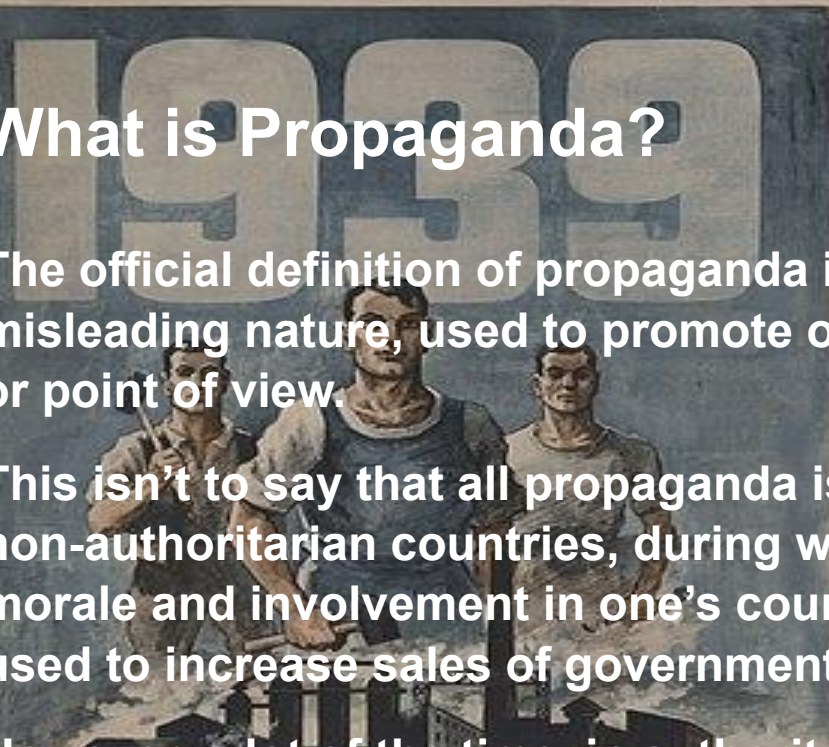

However, a lot of the time, in authoritarian countries propaganda is used to incite feelings of hate towards other countries and even members of the home country itself as we have seen in the past.



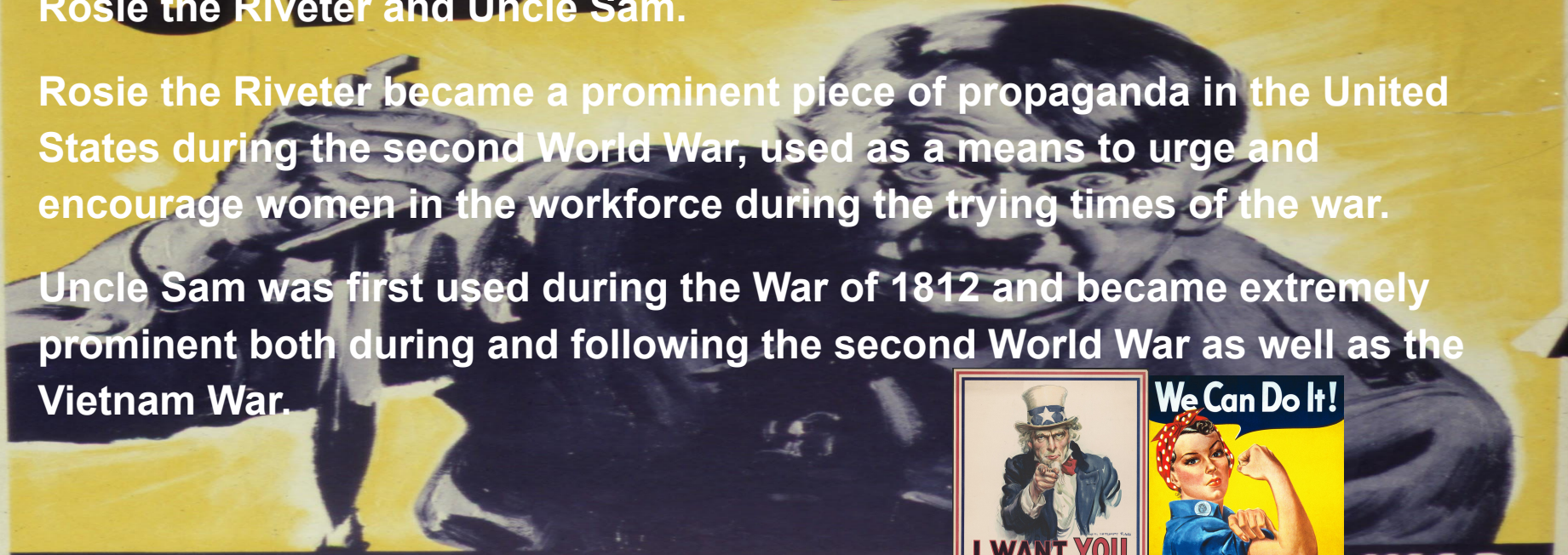
