

Important Statutes in な U.S. Housing Policv

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Depression Era - 1974

1934 - National Housing Act

- Established FHA
- Loan Disparities

1937 - United States Housing Act

- Provided Federal Subsidies
- Less federal construction projects Federal \$\$\$ funding local housing

1968 - Fair Housing Act

- . Protection from discrimination when renting / buying a home
- Ø Department of HUD

1974- Section 8 Amendment

Passed the Housing Choice
 Voucher program

1990 - today

1999 - Faircloth Amendment

- Capped the number of Federal Housing Units
- HUD can only replace existing units

2012 - Rental Assistance Demonstration

 Increases reliance on private sector to pay for housing vouchers



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
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Rising Housing Prices

 - Increasing rent prices



Increase Funding / Accessibility to Housing Choice Vouchers

 HUD suggesting that congress fund at least 140,000 new housing vouchers in the 2023 Transportation-HUD funding bill
